ARCTIC AND ALPINE TUNDRA: regions of far northern Canada and Alaska...
TEMPERATE WESTERN FORESTS: all coniferous forests, pin-yon-juniper and oak woodlands...
ARIDLANDS: all xeric native shrubland habitats of the western United States and Mexico...
MEXICAN PINE-OAK FORESTS: montane pine and pine-oak forests...
TROPICAL DECIDUOUS FORESTS: lowland deciduous, semi-deciduous, and thorn forests...
TROPICAL HIGHLAND FORESTS: cloud forests, evergreen forests at high elevations...
